FLINT HILLS CLASSIC RULES

- Greenwood County 4-H Foundation, Inc./Fair Association and/or Eureka FFA Booster Club will not be held responsible for any damages to, or losses of, property.
- State of Kansas Animal Health Department requirements for county show will be followed.
- Only 4-H and FFA members are eligible to enter. Exhibitors must own the animals shown in showmanship. (If an exhibitor has more than one animal in the same class, they may have another exhibitor show the additional animals.) To show in Showmanship, animals and exhibitors must be entered in a Market or Breeding class.
- No bedding will be allowed and stalls are limited. ALL participants are encouraged to show out of their trailer. Electricity is limited,
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up their area under the barns and in the parking lot.
- Exhibitors will weigh their own animals. Weight cards can be picked up at the check-in table and **must be returned by designated times.**
- The Judge and/or superintendent have the right to request a 5% weigh back. If the weigh back is greater than 5% of the declared weight the exhibitor will be disqualified.
- No intact male animals may be shown, except bucket calves. Banded sheep and goats are accepted.
- The Classic is a full fit show **OR** is up to the exhibitor's fitting preference
- Must have a minimum of three head to make a class.
- Lambs will show slick shorn and free of active club lamb fungus lesions.
- Lambs and Goats are required to have a scrapie tag.
- Market goats must be shown clipped with hair 3/8" or less. Breeding does may be shown with hair.
- Market steer will be shown by breed. Market Heifer will be shown all breeds together. Breeding Heifers will be shown by breed and DOB.
- The Flint Hills Classic management reserves the right to alter and/or combine classes. *Any show day announcements take preference.*
